POLICY FOCUS: **Structured Practical Training Requirements for Pharmacy Technicians**

POLICY STATEMENT(S):

1. Pharmacy technician graduates from a pharmacy technician program in Canada accredited by the Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs (CCAPP) are required to undergo a minimum of 12 weeks of structured practical training (SPT) of which 8 weeks of practical training within the CCAPP accredited program may be applied towards the full 12-week requirement.
2. SPT must be completed in a licensed pharmacy in B.C. and under the supervision of a full pharmacist or pharmacy technician registered in B.C.
