E-Tips is a series of eight web-based, interactive education modules to help develop skills and confidence for health care preceptors, clinical educators, fieldwork supervisors, mentors and more.

If you are a health care practitioner who participates in the education of students and new staff, E-Tips will enhance your role through quick tips, ideas and activities.
